Books, DVDs, and CDs, will be available with prices starting at \$1 for paperbacks and \$3 for hardback books. Items include mysteries, romances, classics, children's books, local histories, cookbooks and a variety of non-fiction topics. Children's books start at just \$0.50 each. Last year's annual Spring Book Sale raised more than \$6,000, and this year the Friends hope to exceed that amount. All proceeds raised at the book sale go directly to the Charleston County Public Library System.
